



## Phyllis Noad Wollman

July 6, 1932 - November 26, 2007

Surrounded by her loved ones at home, Phyllis Louise Noad Wollman, 75, began her journey home to our Lord on November 26th 2007 after a long courageous battle with cancer. She was the widow of Albert H. Wollman, Sr., who died in 1975. Born in Torrington, she lived in New Britain since 1951. A graduate of Torrington High School, Class of 1949, she graduated from the New Britain General Hospital School of Nursing as an RN in 1952. Phyllis started in the Labor & Delivery Unit at New Britain General Hospital and later became evening supervisor, retiring in 1989 after 39 years of service. She also worked for 10 years as a nursing supervisor at Brittany Farms Health Center.

Surviving are two sons, Albert Wollman, Jr. and Timothy Wollman, both of New Britain; a daughter, Nancy Mirles of Groton; two brothers, Vernon Noad Jr. and his wife Dorie of Torrington, and William Noad and his longtime companion Sandy of Winsted; three sisters, Elizabeth Wesley and her husband Calvin of Clifton, NJ; Barbara Whitecage and her husband William of Jacksonville, FL; and Janet Colombie and her husband Richard of New Hartford; three grandchildren, Stacey Wollman, Timothy Wollman Jr., and Matthew Mirles; a great granddaughter Isabella; several nieces and nephews. Besides her husband Albert, she was predeceased by two grandsons, Stephen Albert Wollman and Brandon Thomas Wollman.
