



Priscilla Hardy Bennett

April 6, 1921 - June 6, 2008

Priscilla Hardy Bennett, 87, of Farmington, widow of Frank E. Bennett, passed away Friday June 6, 2008 at Hartford Hospital. Born in Bangor, Maine, she was a former New Britain resident, moving to Farmington in 1966. A graduate of Bangor High School, she received her Bachelor's Degree in Music from the University of Maine at Orono in 1943 and a Master in Elementary Education from CCSC. Priscilla was an elementary school teacher at several schools in New Britain for 25 years, retiring in 1985. She was a lifelong member of the Methodist Church in Bangor, Maine, New Britain and recently in West Hartford; served as president of the New Britain UMW; was a member of the Cardiac Rehab Group at the New Britain YMCA for 20 years; and was a former member of Martha Chapter, Order of Easter Star. Priscilla also belonged to the Farmington Senior Citizen Center and its knitting group; was a member of the Alumni Club of the University of Maine; the Kappa Delta Pi Sorority and the Monday Morning Mission at West Hartford United Methodist Church.

Surviving is a son, Garry Bennett and his wife Katherine of Avon; a daughter, Carolyn D'Annolfo and her husband Kenneth of Farmington; a brother, Malcolm D. Hardy of Hampden, Maine; three grandsons, Kenneth D'Annolfo of Canton; Brian D'Annolfo and his wife Amy of Unionville; and Scott Bennett of Plainville; two great grandsons, Cody and Evan D'Annolfo; a cousin, Edward Hardy and his wife Helen of Florence, Mass; and three nephews,

David, Timothy and Jonathan Hardy.
