Ralph "Buddy" Chant, 77, of Southington, passed away Monday (August 20, 2018). Born in New Britain, he lived in Berlin for 50 years, moving to Southington in 2002. A graduate of Berlin High School, Class of 1958, he served with the US Navy, recently worked as a courier for Hartford Healthcare.
