



## Raymond H. Sachs Sr.

February 7, 1931 - May 29, 2017

Raymond H. Sachs, Sr., 86, of Newington, husband of Ann (Doroski) Sachs, passed away Monday (May 29, 2017) at his home with his family by his side. Born in New Britain, he is a New Britain High School graduate, Class of 1949; and later attended EC Goodwin Technical School. He has been a Newington resident since 1961. A US Air Force veteran of the Korean conflict, Raymond was owner and operator of Sachs Plumbing & Heating for 31 years and later became the plumbing and heating inspector for the City of New Britain for 21 years until his retirement in 2004. He was a member of Church of the Holy Spirit in Newington and the COA (Cromwell Outboard Association). For over 50 years, Ray enjoyed boating and water skiing with his family on the Connecticut River.

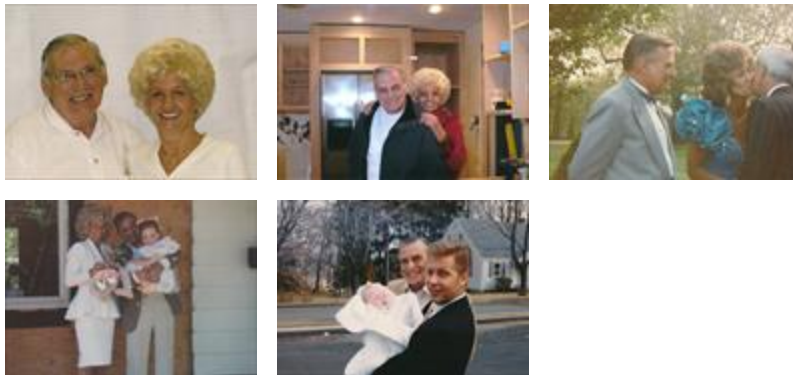
