Regina Yonan Baba, 94, of Plainville, widow of Peter Baba, passed away Sunday May 1, 2011 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain, surrounded by her family. Born in Urmia, Iran, she lived in New Britain most of her life, moving to Plainville in 1983. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1935, she worked at Emhart Corporation in Berlin for 25 years, retiring in 1982. She was a member of St. Marks Episcopal Church; the Altar Guild and St. Marys Guild of the church.
