Richard F. Domanski, 57, of Kensington, passed away at home surrounded by his loving family after a valiant battle with liver disease. Born in New Britain, son of Walter Domanski and Julia Woja McGann, he lived in Kensington for the last 14 years. A graduate of New Britain High School Class of 1967, Richard is a retired Tech Sgt. in the U.S. Air Force, serving his country for 20 years.
