Richard N. Hepp, 79, of Plainville, husband of Olga Keiko Hepp, died Thursday November 7, 2002 at Haven Health Care in Farmington. A native and former New Britain resident, he lived in Plainville since 1961. He attended New Britain High School and was a WWII U.S. Navy veteran. Mr. Hepp was a tool & die maker at Wiremold Co. in Elmwood for 35 years, retiring in 1988.
