Richard W. Juzwik, 77, of West Hartford, husband of Patricia (Paluch) Juzwik, passed away Friday (October 2, 2020) at Hartford Hospital. Born in Winsted, he lived most of his life in New Britain. Richard formerly served in the US Marine Corps and was employed as a Corrections Officer for the State of CT serving at Somers State Prison from 1976 to 1993, then at Walker Correctional Institute from 1993 until his retirement in 1996.

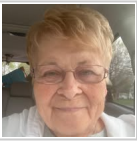
