Richard W. Murphy, Sr., 71, of Plainville, widower of Betty Beaney Murphy, died Tuesday December 20, 2005 at home. Born in New Britain, son of the late Freeman John and Esther Charlotte Davidson Murphy, he was a former South Carolina resident returning to Plainville in 1998.
