Richard Leonard Reney, 76, of New Britain, CT and West Palm Beach, FL, passed away peacefully Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at home surrounded by his wife and children after spending 15 courageous years battling Lymphoma. He is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Susan Gagnon Reney, 3 children, Michael Reney and his husband Alex Cruz of Boston, Mass., Kristen and David Aldieri of Bristol, CT and Todd and Stacey Reney of Ridgefield, CT. Richard loved his 4 grandchildren Rachel and Abby Aldieri and Tate and Emily Reney. He is survived by his sister, Kathryn LaVette of Berlin, CT and Palm Springs, FL and several nieces and nephews.

Richard attended Mt. St. Charles Academy, Woonsocket, RI. In 1959-61, he enlisted in the United States Army 7th Armored Cavalry. In 1962, he graduated from the Connecticut Institute of Hair Dressing, yet only worked as a hair dresser for a short time. Richard was involved in many business adventures. He joined his father, TJ, at Reney's Billiards Academy and also ran T & R Reney Maintenance. In 1970, Richard opened a Carvel franchise in CT. He also founded Reney Realty and Insurance with his wife, Susan, and Reney Tours where he worked with his daughter, Kristen, for the past 25 years.

Richard was a member of Indian Hill Country Club in Newington, CT and Bear Lakes Country Club, West Palm Beach, FL. He loved spending time with his family and his friends all over the country. His love for sunsets, fireworks, horse racing, golf, traveling, the stock market and all sporting events will live
