



## Robert Z. "Bob" Baba

Robert "Bob" Z. Baba, 80, of Southington, husband of Nina (Arsinous) Baba, passed away Thursday (August 5, 2021) at Hartford Hospital. Born in Habbaniyah, Iraq; he has lived in New Britain, CT since 1967 before moving to Southington one month ago. Bob was a member of the Painters Union and worked for several area contractors.
