Robert G. Bryant, 78, of Manchester, husband of Andrea Jean Bryant, died Friday February 10, 2006 at Haven Health Center of Rocky Hill. Born in New Britain, he was a former Bloomfield resident, moving to Manchester in 1990. Bob was a graduate of New Britain High School class of 1945 and was a WWII Marine Corp Veteran. Bob was the owner of Towne Furniture in Hartford and later the owner of Waterbeds of Manchester, retiring in 1993. After his retirement, he assisted his son Thomas at his son's business Lox, Stock and Bagels of West Hartford where he was known as the "Soup Maker". He was a member of the Windsor Elks Club.
