Robert K. "Bob" Gordon, 90, of New Britain, husband of Irene (Noury) Gordon, passed away Friday (October 11, 2019) at the Hospital of Central Connecticut in New Britain. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, he was the son of William and Gladys (Wheeler) Gordon. Bob graduated from New Britain High School, class of 1949) and served for four years with the US Air Force during the Korean Conflict. He worked at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft in East Hartford as a jet fuel technician for thirty eight years, retiring in 1992.
