Robert T. Groman, 85, of New Britain, husband of Helene Rinas Groman, passed away Monday Feb 9, 2009 at Walnut Hill Care Center. A lifelong New Britain resident, he was son of the late Rudolph and Pearl McKinstry Groman. A second generation electrical contractor, he operated the Bob Groman Electric Company for 25 years, retiring in 1988. He was a member of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church and served as a church elder, former Chairman of the Board of Trustees; former President of the St. Matthew's Mr & Mrs Club; was coach in the New Britain area church fast pitch league; and was former president of the New Britain Area Electric League.

Besides his wife Helene, he leaves a son, Scott Groman of New Britain; a sister, Phyllis Niewinski and her husband Lawrence of New Britain; three grandchildren, Paul Binkhuysen; Eric Groman and Jennifer Groman, all of New Britain; several nieces and nephews.
