



## Robert H. Kosswig

April 9, 1926 - September 19, 2004

Robert H. Kosswig, 78, of the Rocky Hill Veterans Home and Hospital, a former New Britain resident, died Sunday September 19, 2004. He was the widower of Elizabeth "Betty" Bianca Kosswig, who died in 1988. Born in New Britain, he lived in Newington for 14 years, Hamden for 8 years, before moving to Rocky Hill in 2001. A World War II U.S. Navy veteran, Bob was custodian at the First Lutheran Church in New Britain for 7 years and later worked at Fafnir Bearing Company for 5 years, retiring in 1984. He was a former member of St. Ann's Church in New Britain.

Surviving are three sons, Robert M. Kosswig of Plainville; Dennis Kosswig and his wife Lillian also of Plainville; and Christopher Kosswig and his wife Jane of New Britain; a brother, Norman Kosswig and his wife Joan in Alabama; two sisters, Betty Ann Zipke of Plymouth; and Lorraine Christensen of New Britain; 11 grandchildren; a great grandson, Jacob; several nieces and nephews.
