



## Robert F. Pawlow

January 21, 1927 - March 12, 2008

Robert F. "Bob" Pawlow, 81, of New Britain, widower of Constance Miano Pawlow, passed away peacefully Wednesday March 12, 2008 at St. Mary Home in West Hartford after a courageous battle with cancer. He was the son of the late Frank E. and Margaret Mary Murphy Pawlow. Bob was a New Britain native and lifelong resident. He attended New Britain High School, leaving to join the Navy in World War II, serving in the Atlantic theater of operations. Upon his return, he graduated from the Veteran's High School at Hartford High School and Wilcox Technical School, Meriden. He was employed at the New Britain Machine Company as a sheet metal mechanic and steam fitter for 38 years retiring in 1989. Bob was a former Secretary/Treasurer of the International Association Of Machinist & Aerospace Workers Union, Lodge 1021; past President of the New Britain Machine Company retirees club; a member of the Connecticut Chevrolet Connection Car Club; and Past President of the former ENBEE Employees Federal Credit Union. He was a member of St. Ann Church. Bob spent his retirement years pursuing his love of classic cars. He enjoyed annual trips to the Hershey car show with his great friends Bill & Billy Hannon.

Surviving are two daughters, Mary-Margaret Gaudio and her husband Philip; and two grandsons, P.J. Gaudio III and Max Gaudio who were the pride and joy in his life; a daughter, Barbara Pawlow; a brother, Frank Pawlow and his wife Louise; two brothers-in-law, Thomas P Miano and his wife Anna; and
