Robert P. Sanzo, 62, of New Britain, passed away unexpectedly Thursday (November 9, 2017). Born in West Hartford, he lived in New Britain before moving to Kensington for 28 years and returned to New Britain 2 years ago. He was a graduate of Robinson Prep and Roger Williams College, formerly worked at Commercial Plumbing Supply for many years, and later owned Executive Security Associates for 5 years.

Surviving are his parents, Peter and Adeline (Gagliardi) Sanzo of New Britain; a son, Peter "PJ" Sanzo and his fiancée, Heather Klein of Enfield; a daughter, Joy Sanzo of Middletown; a sister, Judi Sanzo and her husband Mitchell Dembin of San Diego, CA; He was predeceased by a brother, Richard Sanzo.
