Robert "Bob" Smith, 84, of Port St. Lucie, FL passed away Friday, December 22, 2017. Born and raised in New Britain, he was a former Plainville resident, moving to Florida in 1992. He was the son of the late Leona Smith and was a member of the former Trinity United Methodist Church in New Britain.

Bob attended New Britain High School before entering the National Guard and the Army. He was honorably discharged from the Army in 1952. He served in the New Britain Police Department from 1955 to 1991 and retired as a Sergeant. Bob was a member of Friendship Lodge, AF&AM in Southington; was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Sphinx Temple Shrine in Newington.
