



Robert L. Sorrentino

December 12, 1919 - October 8, 2002

Robert Sorrentino, 82, of Bassett Street, New Britain, died Sunday October 6, 2002 at New Britain General Hospital. He was the widower of Katherine Riley Sorrentino, who died in 1996. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, he was the son of the late Orazio and Mary Mazzoni Sorrentino, and was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1939. Mr. Sorrentino owned and operated the former Acorn Centerless Grinding Company for 15 years. He later worked at Bland Corp. in West Hartford, retiring in 1984. Active in local politics, he was a former member of the New Britain Democratic Town Committee. He was a member of St. Ann's Church and the Italian Fraternal Society.

Surviving is his sister, Gloria Caliendo of New Britain and several nieces and nephews. Besides his wife and parents, he was predeceased by a brother, Joseph Sorrentino and two sisters, Vincentia Sorrentino and Jeanette DiFronzo.

Funeral services will be held Thursday 8:45 AM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Square New Britain followed by a Mass of Christian Burial 9:30 AM at St. Ann's Church.
