



## Roland LaReau Sr.

September 4, 1923 - March 1, 2018

Roland J. LaReau Sr., 94, of West Hartford, passed away Thursday (March 1, 2018) at UConn Health Center in Farmington. A lifelong Connecticut resident, Roland lived in New Britain and Winsted before moving to West Hartford. He was a World War II US Army Air Corp veteran. After the war, he worked at Pratt & Whitney as a chrome plater and later worked for Holokrome in West Hartford, retiring in 1992. Roland was a member of Church of God-Lighthouse Family Worship Center in New Britain, was the oldest living member of the church and served as church deacon.

Roland is survived by his wife Anna (Polonchak) LaReau of West Hartford; two sons, Roland "Sonny" J. LaReau Jr. and his wife Brenda of Port Charlotte, FL, and Norman LaReau of Mesa, AZ; one daughter, Laura Staski of New Britain; four step children, Nancy Webber, Mary Klett, Tony LaReau and John Millet; several step grandchildren.
