Ruth Soper Deutsch, 85, of New Britain died Sunday October 6, 2002 at New Britain General Hospital. She was the widow of Emil R. Deutsch Sr., who died in 1989. Born in Springfield Mass, she was a longtime New Britain resident, and was a nurse in her younger years. Mrs. Deutsch was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church in New Britain and the St. Elizabeth's Guild at the church.
