



Ruth Johnson Sues

January 28, 1909 - February 8, 2007

Ruth Johnson Sues, 98, of Tolland, widow of William F. Sues, died Thursday February 8, 2007 at her home. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Adna and Anna Guenther Johnson, she is a New Britain High School graduate, Class of 1926, and a graduate of the New Britain General Hospital School of Nursing in 1935. Ruth was a Kensington resident for 35 years, until moving to Tolland in 1994. She was employed as an office nurse for Dr. Donald Bristol in New Britain for many years and the Berlin Public Health Nursing Services for 17 years, retiring in 1977. Ruth was the longest tenured member of South Church in New Britain, being a member since 1923. She was also a member of the New Britain General Hospital Alumni.

Surviving are two daughters, Linda Sues of Tolland with whom she made her home; and Judith Chevalier of Kissimmee, FL; two sisters-in-law, Doris Anderson of Kensington and Vera Sues of Manchester; two grandchildren, Lynn Dzialo and William Chevalier, both of Kissimmee, FL; two great grandchildren, Stephanie and Andy Dzialo; several nieces and nephews. Ruth was predeceased by three brothers, Adna, Frank and Robert F. Johnson.
