Samuel J. Hormis, 75, of Black Rock Ave., New Britain, husband of Helen Sargis Hormis, died yesterday April 16, 2002 at New Britain General Hospital. A lifelong New Britain resident, he was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1945. A World War II U.S. Army veteran, he served in the Pacific Theatre and was a Purple Heart recipient. Mr. Hormis was employed at Peter Paul Electronics in New Britain, retiring in 1987. He was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church; VFW Post 9836 in Newington; and the Eddy Glover Post American Legion in New Britain.
