



## Samuel C. Stub

December 10, 1911 - October 2, 2003

Samuel C. Stub, 91, of Kensington, died Thursday October 2, 2003 at his home. He was the widower of Catherine MacLeod Stub, who died in 1999. Born in Jersey City, New Jersey, son of the late Bjarne and Julia Stub, he was raised by his step-parents, Claire and Elmer Norton in Syracuse, NY. A former resident of Bronxville and Elmhurst, NY, he lived in Kensington since 1986. A World War II US Army veteran, he was a dock builder and carpenter for the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners in New York City, until his retirement in 1976.
