Sarah Wild-Jones (Ms. Jones), 44, of New Britain, wife of James M. Jones, passed away Thursday (March 7, 2024) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. Sarah was a native and lifelong New Britain resident and graduated from New Britain High School, Class of 1997 (Naughty-Seven). Sarah received her Bachelor's Degree and her Master's degree in Public History from Central CT State University. Sarah was a lover of ALL dogs, time spent at Sebago Lake, being at the beach, QVC, UCONN basketball, and the Celtics. She was a history teacher at New Britain High School and has loved every day with her students for the last 17 years. She was voted Teacher of the Year in 2021 by her colleagues. Prior to teaching, Sarah spent many years working with her friends and colleagues at New Britain Parks and Recreation. Sarah is survived by her husband and high school sweetheart James, her son James W.W. Jones (HB) and her daughter Analise Jones (her hottest babe).
