Sebastian T. Cianci, 90, of Plantsville, died Wednesday October 15, 2003 at New Britain General Hospital. He was the widower of Antoinette Leveiro Cianci, who died in 1978. A New Britain native and long time resident, he moved to Plantsville in 1980. During World War II, he received a medal from the city of New Britain for services performed on the homefront. He was employed at Pratt & Whitney in West Hartford for over 20 years, retiring in 1975. Sebastian was a member of St. Ann's Church in New Britain; was a former member of the New Britain Elk's Club; Calender House Seniors in Southington and Pratt & Whitney Seniors. He attended St. Thomas Church in Southington.
