Sharyn A. Young Everson, 69, of Wallingford, passed away on Saturday March 14, 2015 at her home. She was the loving wife of Philip G. Everson. She was born June 23, 1945 in New Milford, CT and was the daughter of the late Francis C. and Anna M. Straub Young.

Sharyn spent her childhood on Lake Candlewood and graduated from New Milford High School on her birthday in 1963. "Sherry" known by family and friends worked at CL&P in New Milford, Northeast Utilities in Rocky Hill and in Berlin for over 16 years.
