Sherwood H. Raymond, Jr., 87, of Farmington, died June 21, 2001. Born in New Britain, he moved to Wilton in 1960, then to Cape Cod in 1979, before moving to Farmington in 1995. He was employed by Landers, Frary & Clark for 20 years and then by Fafnir Bearing for 11 years. He relocated to Wilton as Executive Director of United Way of Norwalk, Westport, Weston and Wilton. He assumed the position of Director of Development of Norwalk Hospital until his retirement in 1979. Mr. Raymond was an active member and fundraiser of multiple community services including, Boy Scouts of America where he received the high honor of Silver Beaver; the American Red Cross; the Masons; the Civitan Club; Norwalk Community College; Cape Cod Museum of Naural History; multiple community choral groups; S. Yarmouth library and his alma-mater, Trinity College.

He is survived by his wife Grace Goldsborough Raymond; 1 daughter Marcy Goodwin and her husband Mark; 2 sons Thomas Raymond and his wife Vicki, all of Bethel; Richard Raymond and his wife Eve of Westport; a brother, Gordon Raymond and his wife Shirley of Southington; 5 grandchildren; 4 great grandchildren; and 6 nieces.
