September 30, 1918 - December 7, 2003

Shirley J. Williamson, 85, of Rocky Hill, went to be with the Lord Sunday December 7, 2003. Born and lived in the same house in Woodhaven Queens, NY, for 75 years. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Mary Baldwin College in Staunton, VA, and worked for many years as an executive secretary at Corn Products Corporation. She was a former chairwoman of the Board of Deacons, Sunday School teacher, and choir member at Christ Congregational Church in Woodhaven. She volunteered with the Red Cross during World War II, and was a volunteer tutor at Our Saviour Lutheran School in Queens. She was also a fifty year member of the Order of the Eastern Star, and a popular soloist for many of their functions.

She is survived by her husband of over 47 years, Alfred J. Williamson of Rocky Hill; her son and daughter-in-law, the Rev. David Williamson and the Rev. Julia Williamson of Kensington; and her beloved grandson, James.

A memorial service will be held on Friday at 11 AM in Kensington Congregational Church, 312 Percival Avenue Route 71. There are no calling hours. Interment will be at Cypress Hills Cemetery in Brooklyn, NY, at the convenience of the family.
