Stanley R. Borkowski, 81 of Newington, husband of Ruth Lawrence Borkowski, died Wednesday December 4, 2002 at Hartford Hospital. Born in New Britain, he lived in Newington since 1951. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1941, he was a World War II U.S. Navy veteran. Mr. Borkowski was employed at Southern New England Telephone in the PBX unit for 39 years, retiring in 1983. He was a member of the United Methodist Church of Newington; Eddy Glover Post 6, American Legion, New Britain; and was a retired member of Newington Volunteer Fire Department #2. Besides his wife, he leaves a son Richard Borkowski and his wife Carol of Conway, SC; 3 daughters, Joan Ryan and her husband William of Laramie, WY; Susan Pepin and her husband Bernard of Prince Edward Island, Canada; and Mary Ann Porreca and her husband Michael of Wayland, Mass; a brother, Leonard Borkowski and his wife Irene of Newington; a sister, Nellie Petanovitch of Newington; 8 grandchildren; 5 grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.
