Stefan Melnyk, 83, of Newington, husband of Irene (Lewczak) Melnyk, passed away Saturday (June 10, 2017) at Bel Aire Manor in Newington. Born in Poland, Stefan is a former New Britain resident, moving to Newington in 1974. He was employed as a Tool Maker for New Britain Machine Company and later Standard Knapp in Portland, retiring in 1999. Stefan was a member of St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church in New Britain; was a former member of the church council and the church cemetery board and was an active member with the Bundles for Ukraine group.
