Syble Penn Griffin, 81, of Governors House, Simsbury, formerly of Marigold Dr., New Britain, died Saturday June 23, 2001 at St. Francis Hospital, Hartford. She was the widow of William E. Griffin, Jr. who died in 1998. Born in Gotebo, Oklahoma, she lived in New Britain since 1955. A graduate of Central State College in Oklahoma, she received her Masters from CCSU and taught home economics in the New Britain School System for 23 years, retiring from Pulaski High School in 1978.

Syble was a member of the First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain; the Womens Federation at the church; and served as former treasurer of social service at the church. She was a member of the Woman's Club of New Britain; the Cape Cod Unit, Caravan Club; the New Britain Teachers Club; and was a former blood bank captain for the New Britain Red Cross. During her time at Pulaski High School she was advisor for the Girls League. Surviving are 2 sons William E. Griffin, III and his wife Kay of West Simsbury; and Ray E. Griffin of Cloverdale, Virginia; 2 grandsons, Geoffrey Bloom of Peoria, IL and Michael P. Griffin of Tucson, AZ; several nieces and nephews.
