



## Theresa (Tosatti) Matyka

Theresa Marie (Tosatti) Matyka, 100, of Cromwell, formerly of New Britain and Lyme, passed away peacefully Tuesday (May 19, 2020) surrounded by her family at her home. She was the daughter of the late Anselmo and Flaminia Tosatti, she graduated from New Britain High School, class of 1938.
