



Thomas Bartumioli

July 25, 1920 - July 15, 2007

Thomas Bartumioli, 86, of New Britain, died unexpectedly Sunday July 15, 2007. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, he was a World War II US Army veteran serving in the 21st Infantry Regiment of the 24th Infantry Division in the Pacific theater and was a Purple Heart recipient. Tom was retired from the New Britain Public Works Department and was a member of St. Ann's Church.

Surviving are two nieces, Maria DeConti of New Britain, and Margaret Marzi and her husband Gary of Berlin; a nephew, Thomas DeConti and his wife Judith of East Hartford; a grandniece, Lisa Marzi and a grandnephew, Anthony Marzi. Tom was predeceased by two brothers, Primo and Joseph, and by three sisters, Louise, Anna and Rose. He will be dearly missed by all his family and friends.
