Thomas Grodesky, 54, of Berlin, died Wednesday July 30, 2003 at Connecticut Hospice in Branford. Born in Middletown, he was a former New Britain resident, moving to Berlin 35 years ago. A U.S. Navy veteran of the Vietnam Conflict, he was employed at Atlantic Globe in Farmington for 10 years, retiring in 2002.
