



Vincent "Jimmy" Failla

Vincent "Jimmy" Failla, 94, of Windsor Locks, passed away Wednesday (May 20, 2026) at Stonebrook Village of Windsor Locks. A New Britain native and longtime resident of 120 Whiting Street, he moved to Windsor Locks in 2023. Vincent was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1949, and served in the US Air Force during the Korean War. He was employed at United Technologies Research Center in East Hartford for 30 years, retiring in 1990. Jimmy was a member of St. Ann Church in New Britain; a life member of the American Legion and active with the CT Chapter Disabled American Veterans (DAV). An avid hiker and mountain climber, he was also active with the Thunderbird Alumni Association and reunited at the 50th Anniversary Reunion with other first team members of the Thunderbirds.

Surviving are two nephews, Charles Okulicz and his wife Nancy of Windsor Locks; and Frank E. Failla, Jr. of New Britain. As well as several cousins.
