Vincenzo A. Liburdi, Jr., 81, of Kensington, widower of Nicoletta Palumbo Liburdi, passed away peacefully Thursday April 12, 2012 at home. Born in Frosinone, Italy, son of the late Vincenzo Liburdi Sr. and Ascenza Desantis Liburdi, he was a former New Britain resident, moving to Kensington in 1996. Vincenzo was employed at Hygrade Tool & Die in Plainville for over 25 years, and then in the Key Shop of CCSU for 10 years, retiring in 1995.
