



## Vito V. "Weets" Piccoli

January 15, 1920 - January 5, 2002

Vito V. "Weets" Piccoli, 81, of Brook Street, New Britain, died Saturday January 5, 2002 at New Britain General hospital. he was the widower of Celia Martinelli Piccoli who died Nov. 21, 2000. Born in Bristol, he was a New Britain resident most of his life. A U.S. Army veteran of World War II, he served in the Pacific Theatre and was awarded the Bronze Star and Purple Heart. mr.
