



## Walter Sven Carlson

May 31, 1915 - April 3, 2004

Walter S. Carlson, 88, of North Eastham, Mass, widower of Marjorie Campbell Carlson who died in 1991, died Saturday April 3, 2004 at Cope Cod Hospital in Hyannis, Mass. Born in New Britain, son of the late August and Selma Anderson Carlson, Walter was a New Britain resident until moving to Southington in 1955, and finally retiring to the Cape in 1978. Walter was employed as a Supervisor at General Electric for 33 years, until his retirement in 1978. He was a former member of First Lutheran Church and a Committee Member for the Boy Scouts Troop 17 at the church.

Surviving is a son, Walter C. Carlson and his wife Linda of Kensington; a daughter, Margaret E.
