



Walter Bailey Johnson

October 28, 1924 - August 14, 2001

Walter Bailey Johnson, 76, of Bassett St. New Britain, died Tuesday August 14, 2001, at New Britain General Hospital. Born in Luesdale, Mississippi, he moved to New Britain in 1942, lived in Florida for 9 years, returning to New Britain in 1997. A World War II Army veteran, he worked at Tectonic Industries in Berlin for 11 years, retiring in 1982. Mr. Johnson was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in New Britain; the New Britain VFW Post; and was a former member and past governor of the Loyal Order of Moose in Kensington.

Surviving is his wife, Palma Campana Johnson; a son, Wayne Johnson of Hartford; a sister, Helen Jansen of Fairhope, Alabama; and several nieces and nephews including Carol Reed of New Britain; Wayne C. Johnson of Brawley, CA; Daryl Jansen in New Mexico; and Michael Jansen of Fairhope, Alabama. He was predeceased by a brother Clinton W. Johnson and a sister Dolamae Johnson.
