Walter Kotyk, 84, of Southington, husband of Alice Korbabicz Kotyk, passed away Thursday November 27, 2008 at the Hospital of Central CT in Southington. A New Britain native and longtime resident, he lived in Lisbon, CT for 10 years before returning to New Britain. He lived in Southington the past two years. Walter served actively with the US Navy for 22 years and was employed for the State of CT Dept of Transportation for 20 years, retiring in 1982. He was a member of St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church in New Britain and was a Past Master of both the Mount Vernon Lodge AF&AM in Versailles, CT and Unity Lodge AF&AM in New Britain. A 32nd Degree Scottish Right Mason, he was also a member of Sphinx Temple Shrine; the Ukrainian Veterans Association and the American Iris Society.
