Warren McKinley Fisher, 83, of Plainville, husband of Doris Johnson Fisher, died Thursday February 8, 2007 at UConn Medical Center in Farmington. Born in New Britain, Warren has been a Plainville resident since 1952. A graduate of New Britain High School, Warren was a World War II U.S. Navy veteran and was employed at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft in East Hartford for 35 years, retiring in 1982.
