



Wesley J. Codrington

Wesley J. Codrington, 62, of Bloomfield, beloved husband of Linda Hill Codrington, passed away Saturday November 28, 2015 at Bloomfield Health and Rehab. Born in Queens, NY, Wesley has been a Connecticut resident since 1985 and resided in Bloomfield since 1995. Wesley received a Certificate of Theology from Emmanuel Baptist Theological Seminary in Newington. He was employed at Lincoln Financial Group in Hartford for 25 years, then briefly at New York Life at the Trumbull Office, retiring in 2014.

Wesley was born in a Christian home. As a teenager, he repented of his sins and accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour. He loved and trusted Jesus and he loved the local church. He served in the local assembly as an usher, children's bible teacher and deacon. At his death, he was a faithful member of Bible Baptist Church of Cromwell.

Besides his wife Linda, he leaves two sons, Joseph and Daniel Codrington both of Bloomfield; his mother, Alvina Jenkins Codrington of Atlanta, GA; two brothers, Philip Codrington and his wife Nicole of Queens, NY and Steven Codrington of Elmont, NY; three sisters, Linda V. Codrington of Stuart, FL; Alvina Markes of Atlanta, GA; and Alison Gray and her husband Charles also of Atlanta; several nieces, nephews and cousins. Wesley was predeceased by his son Wesley Joseph Codrington Jr.; his father, Wesley F. Codrington; his brother Brian Codrington and his sister Robin Codrington.

Funeral services will be held Saturday 12:30 PM at Emmanuel Baptist Church, 296 New Britain Avenue, Newington. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery, New Britain.
