



## Wilbur R. Stoddard

February 22, 1927 - August 23, 2007

Wilbur R. Stoddard, 80, of Newington, widower of Barbara Huggins Stoddard, died Thursday August 23, 2007 at Hartford Hospital. A World War II US Navy veteran, Wilbur was a Newington resident most of his life. He was employed in Appliance Sales and Service for the former Viking-Bakery in West Hartford for 20 years, until operating Ray L. Stoddard Company in Newington for 25 years, retiring in 1988. He is a member of Wellspring Church formerly Kensington Baptist Church; was a 32 year member of Sequin Lodge #140 AF&AM in Newington; and a member of the May Davis American Legion Post #117 of Newington.

Surviving are three sons, Wilbur J. Stoddard and his wife Mary of Oxford, CT, Timothy Stoddard and his wife Jennifer of Hebron, and Daniel Stoddard and his wife Jacqueline of Twin Cities, Minnesota; a daughter, Susan Stough and her husband Louis of Bowie, Maryland; a sister; ten grandchildren; a niece and two nephews.
