William "Bill" Aiudi, 67, of New Britain, widower of Nancy (Lewis) Aiudi, passed away Sunday (February 18, 2018) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, Bill was son of Doris (Gottlin) Aiudi of New Britain and the late Joseph J. Aiudi.
