William C. Neidl, Jr., 90, of Southington, passed away on Saturday January 13, 2007 at Haven Health Center of Farmington after a long illness. He was born on December 23, 1916 in New Britain to William and Jennie Ronstrom Neidl, then moved to Southington 37 years ago. He was also the grandson of William Joseph Neidl who was awarded a gold medal from the US government for his many genius inventions which are still in common use today. Bill was predeceased by a brother, George Neidl of Roseville, CA; his loving wife of 31 years, Helen Charnick Neidl and his second wife Millie Capraszewski Neidl.

Surviving are three daughters, Susan Wassil of New Britain; Drue Signarelli of Ontario, Canada; and Doreen Kart of Bristol; five grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, and three great-great grandchildren.
