Winona R. Anderson, 88, of Kensington, passed away Tuesday January 6, 2015 at Bayview Healthcare Center in Waterford. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Edwin and Eva Almquist Anderson, she is a graduate of New Britain High School class of 1944 and lived in Kensington since 1963. Winona graduated from Newton-Wellesley Hospital School of Nursing in Massachusetts in 1948. She was an RN at the New Britain General Hospital and was head of Central Supply before becoming head of the Epidemiology Department, retiring after 38 years in 1991. She was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain, formerly served on the Church Council and was also part of the church's Mid Ways group.

Surviving is a brother, Leonard E. Anderson and his wife Carole of Ellington; a niece, Linda Mann of Old Saybrook; three nephews, Gary Mann of Old Saybrook, Joel Anderson and his wife Diane of Rockville and Craig Anderson and his wife Patty of Enfield; several grandnieces and two grandnephews.
