Zofia Kanchugowska Mazurkiewicz, 83, of Kensington, died Wednesday July 23, 2003 at Walnut Hill Care Center. She was the widow of Micholaj Mazurkiewicz. Born in Lublin, Poland, she lived in New Britain for 32 years, moving to Kensington in 1999.
